## Submission Checklist for Authors

Before submitting your manuscript to **AATCC Review**, please ensure that all the following points are thoroughly completed. Submissions that do not meet these requirements may be returned for revision.

### 1. Preparation and Review

Read the **Instructions for Authors** carefully before submission.

Review the **Sample Manuscript Template** provided on the journal's website to ensure proper formatting and structure.

Confirm that your manuscript adheres to the **scope** and **ethical standards** of AATCC Review.

### 2. Manuscript Format

Use the official **AATCC Review manuscript template**.

The **title** should be clear, concise, and free from symbols such as "&" or unnecessary abbreviations.

Author names should follow the correct order and formatting as per the journal's policy.

All sections (Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References) must be clearly labeled.

### 3. Author Details

The **corresponding author** should be clearly identified with an asterisk (\*).

Provide **complete affiliations** for all authors, including department, institution, city, and country.

Include **ORCID IDs** for all authors (mandatory for corresponding author).

Ensure email addresses and contact information are accurate.

#### **4. Plagiarism and Originality**

Conduct a **plagiarism check** using reliable software before submission.

The **similarity index** must be within acceptable limits (preferably below 15%).

Confirm that the manuscript has not been published or submitted elsewhere.

#### **5. Keywords**

Provide **4–8 relevant keywords** that reflect the main content and theme of your article.

Avoid repeating words from the title.

#### **6. Tables**

All **tables** must be clearly numbered and appropriately titled.

Prepare tables using **Microsoft Word** (not images).

Keep tables concise and avoid excessively long data presentations.

#### **7. Figures and Illustrations**

Figures must be **numbered sequentially** and referred to in the text.

All figures should be **high resolution (minimum 300 DPI)** and submitted in **TIFF, JPEG, PNG, or PSD format**.

Ensure clarity—no blurred or distorted images.

Text, labels, and symbols within figures must be **readable and clear**.

Use only scientifically relevant photographs or illustrations.

#### **8. Citations and References**

All **in-text citations** must be numbered sequentially using **superscript format**.

Ensure every citation in the text appears in the **reference list**.

Follow the **AATCC Review Reference Style (AMA format)** strictly.

Cross-check accuracy of author names, publication years, and DOI links (if available).

## 9. Reference Guidelines

Include all **relevant and up-to-date sources**, such as journal articles, books, reports, and theses.

Avoid excessive self-citations.

If citing **preprints or theses**, clearly declare them in the **cover letter** and reference list.

## 10. Cover Letter

A **cover letter** is mandatory with all submissions.

It should introduce your article, emphasizing its **novelty, objectives, and main findings**.

Mention the **type of manuscript** (Original Research, Review, Short Communication, etc.).

Include the following details:

Total word count (excluding tables and figures)

Number of references

Number of tables and figures included

## 11. Mandatory Sections

Ensure that all the following sections are included in your manuscript (where applicable):

**Acknowledgment**

**Funding Information** (include grant numbers if any)

**Conflict of Interest Statement**

**Data Availability Statement**

**Ethics Statement** (if research involves humans or animals)

**Informed Consent Statement** (if applicable)

**Clinical Trial Registration Number** (if applicable)

**Author Contributions**

## **12. Language and Editing**

Manuscripts must be written in **clear, grammatical English**.

Perform thorough **language and technical editing** prior to submission.

Use **British or American English consistently**, not a mix of both.

Avoid spelling or formatting errors.

## **13. Final Review**

Verify that all required files (manuscript, figures, tables, supplementary files, copyright form) are included.

Confirm that the manuscript has been approved by **all co-authors** before submission.
